NORMAL PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND COURSE PROGRESSION

- Program Requirements Going into JUNIOR YEAR:
 - 3.7 Weighted GPA
 - 3.0 Unweighted GPA
 - ACT Score of 23 or higher AND
 - ALL Subscores of 20+
 - or
 - SAT Score of 1140 or higher AND
 - Subscores of 500+
 - Math Test 24+, Reading Test 24+, and Writing/Language Test 25+

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS AND COURSE PROGRESSION CHANGES DUE TO COVID-19

- Program Requirements Going Into the 20-21 School Year **ONLY**:
 - 3.7 Weighted GPA
 - 3.0 Unweighted GPA
 - **LAST CHANCE FOR A TEST SCORE**
 - JUNE 13TH ACT -
 - Score of 23 or higher AND
 - ALL Subscores of 20+
 - Registration deadline of MAY 8, 2020
 - or
 - **IF THE JUNE ACT IS CANCELLED**
 - CONDITIONAL admittance will be granted based on GPA.
 - SAT or ACT scores must be obtained to continue in the program in the 21-22 school year.
 - Placement test for math will need to be taken through FGCU.
